

Earth Day Suncatcher



Materials

You can upcycle any kind of clear, thin plastic. Berry boxes and takeout box lids are good ideas for this project.

- Plastic berry box, or other thin clear plastic
- Scissors
- Permanent markers
- 1/8" Circle Punch or regular hole punch
- Twine
- Small twig
- Printout of clip art (optional)



Instructions

1. Cut out 3 circles of plastic. Younger kids may need an adult to do this part.
2. Color each circle with permanent markers. Trace the clipart if you want to.
3. Punch a small hole in each circle using the circle punch or hole punch.
4. Tie each piece to the twig with twine.
5. Tie a loop to the twig so you can hang up your finished suncatcher.
